Reading with Insight

Established in May 2017, the Library branch focusing on the aim of bringing quality education right from primary classes to Class XII has accomplished marvels. To inculcate reading habits among students various activities ranging from organizing a Mega Book Fair, making provision for establishing a three tier Library systems, to library enrichment experience programmes in collaboration with Room to Read India Trust (an NGO), were organized. 80 Publishers from all over the country participated in Book Fair and a total of 13,16,178 lakh books worth Rs 5,67,60,173 were ordered by the schools in an online module. 400 new libraries for Middle schools having high strengths have been introduced. 4178 Primary class room libraries have been setup and 8.5 lakh books worth Rs.4.17 crores have been procured by Govt. Schools.

The Library blog on DOE website provides not only latest circulars and information along with ample E-resources but also imparts a forum to young budding talent.

Project Spoken English

The project Spoken English was initiated by the DOE as part of the series of reforms introduced by the Government of NCT Delhi to enhance the quality of education for the students in its schools and to improve the communication skills of its students in English. It has been the desire of students graduating from the schools of DoE to be given an opportunity to learn spoken English as language and not just as subject so that they are able to communicate effectively in this language. Therefore, DoE started the Project with the targeted 24000 eligible students enrolled on first come first serve basis at 393 Govt. School Centres.

The DoE selected renowned agencies having impeccable record of professionally conducting spoken English classes – Macmillian Publishers India Pvt Ltd., British Council India, Academy for computers Training (Gujarat) Pvt. Ltd. with an independent agency – Trinity College London for evaluation.

In the first Cycle (1st June 2018 to 6th July 2018) total 6994 students completed their training. The remaining 17006 students will be covered in the Second Cycle.

SKY IS THE LIMIT : VOCATIONAL EDUCATION

With an aim to provide appropriate employability skills to the students from **9th to 12th class in Delhi for successful career prospects**, the **Directorate of Education Vocational Branch** has implemented the new scheme of **National Skills Qualification Framework in continuation with old Vocational scheme** by:

- Integrating vocational education with academic courses
- Providing the appropriate employability skills to the young population
- Enabling students livelihood opportunities to lead a quality life
- Making efforts to link education with productivity and reducing the mismatch between demand and supply of Manpower by imparting skill and technical knowledge

Major Activities

- Program Management Unit members from Lend A Hand India and Wadhvani Foundation working towards enhancing quality and providing effective monitoring to the program
- Orientation of Head of Schools to align with vocational program
- Establishment of Vocational labs for different trades in the schools
- Distribution of NSQF and general employability module textbooks to students
- Training of Trainers through Vocational Training Partners
- Career guidance and On Job Training of students enrolled in vocational program
- Organizing Industrial exposure visit and lectures from industry practitioners



Centrally Sponsored Scheme of “Vocationalisation of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education (CSSVSHSE) under NSQF - Class IX to XII

- In the six NSQF subjects (IT, Travel & Tourism, Retail, Automobile Technology, Security, Financial Market Management), 409 labs have been established
- Taught by 596 Vocational Trainers (VTs) hired through NSDC empanelled Vocational Training partners and 2480 Industrial exposure visits and 11010 Guest Lectures were organized.
- Enrolment for academic year 2017-18 was 74424 students across Class IX - XII.
- The students enrolled for Financial Market Management Trade got registered with National Stock Exchange.
- On the job training (approx 06 weeks) for all the Govt. Schools of Delhi under Vocational Stream for Part-Time Vocational Teachers from 11.05.2017 to 30.06.2017.
- Teachers training workshop of Fashion Designing and Garment Technology was organized at SCERT from 10.07.2017 to 14.07.2017.
- Boot camp conducted for the batch of 2017-18 class XII (April 2018) on Soft skill training, General Employability Skills, Mock Interviews and Resume making
- Career Conclave organized for providing guidance to thousands of students on educational and employment prospects.
- On The Job Training conducted for almost 4000 students in all six NSQF subject during summer vacation (May-June 2018)
- Training of Trainers organized for 600 Vocational Trainers in optimally sized batches of 20-25 trainers per Master trainer (June 2018).



Scaling New Heights

To render the qualitative improvement as well as to increase the momentum of reform at Primary stage of education, the Nursery Branch initially started in 155 schools, extended to 143 more school, by equipping them with good infrastructure and materials. Innovative practices like – circle Time, Show and Tell, Special Assembly on the lines of Annual Day with full students' participation, meticulously maintained learning outcomes of every child etc. paved the way for a strong base. A number of Orientation programs and workshops conducted by the DOE ensured the implementation of all the innovative ideas/policies in these schools.

The Primary Branch of the Directorate of Education in collaboration with organizations like – 'Jodo Gyan' and 'Ahvaan' and 'Room to Read India Trust' endeavored to enhance the teaching learning experience and to strengthen the foundations of socially sensitive and value based education so that the teachers can transact the curriculum in an effective manner. Besides, classroom libraries have also been set up in each of the 4178 primary sections across Sarvodaya Vidyalayas.

Worksheets for classes 1 to 3, detailed curriculum booklets for teachers for teaching Nursery classes, Primary support material, Learning outcome record registers for detailed mapping of Learning outcomes of each child, A project File 'Mujhe Jaano aur Pehchano' for all students of Nursery and K G to make them aware of their surroundings have been distributed in the schools.



Awarding Every Child In The Primary school with at least 8 certificates in a year such as WOW / FANTASTIC / WELL DONE / TERRIFIC READER / MATH MAGICIAN / POPULAR CLASSMATE / HELPING HAND, Birthday Card for each child, an expanded kit for all students of Nursery and K.G. containing grip crayons, poster colours, sketch books, Varnmala ki Meri Pustak, Alphabet and Number book and play dough will be provided to the students in the coming session.

1. Report Cards for all classes I to V were designed printed and supplied to all schools.
2. Nursery has been introduced in 143 more schools in 2017-18 to be operational from 2018-19.
3. Three sections each from Nursery to Class 2 has been introduced in the 5 Schools of Excellence in which classes ensued from April, 2018.
4. An integrated in-service programme for continuous professional development of Assistant Teachers was held.
5. An effort was made to bring about cross-disciplinary understanding of not just English, Math's & Hindi but also the importance of Music, expressive art and games, storytelling, child psychology etc.
6. Nearly 3000 Assistant teachers, 72 mentor teachers, 250 HOS, 12 DDEs and 4 RDEs attended the programme for six days having 24 sessions from 10 disciplines.
7. The Multi-disciplinary modules have been prepared in-house synchronizing them with learning outcomes notified by SCERT.
8. Workbooks with illustrations for individual responses and interactive sessions are also under preparation.

THE STATE TEACHERS AWARD 2018

Monitoring and Inspection

Inspection Cell HQ is entrusted with the inspection of Govt. Schools under DOE for observing their functioning and to ensure proper academic and administrative activities according to Rules/Guidelines/instructions issued by the DOE from time to time.

Officers of the DOE conduct Inspection of Govt. Schools throughout the year. For this purpose Month wise Inspection Schedule is prepared and uploaded on MIS with approval of the Competent Authority.

Inspection reports are compiled and scrutinized by the Inspection Branch (HQ). Inspection reports are issued to the HOS of the concerned schools for calling their explanation and ATR.

Necessary directions are conveyed to the HOS for taking remedial action. The Inspection Branch has planned the following type of Inspections : Mandatory Inspection, Surprise Inspection, Panel Inspection, Academic Inspection, . Inspection of Adopted Schools, Inspection under Speical Drives Safety and Security of the Schools, Inspection under Mission Buniyaad, Parent Teachers meeting, Inspection of Libraries, Inspection during Examinations, Inspection Branch conducted total 2735 Inspections during 2017-18.

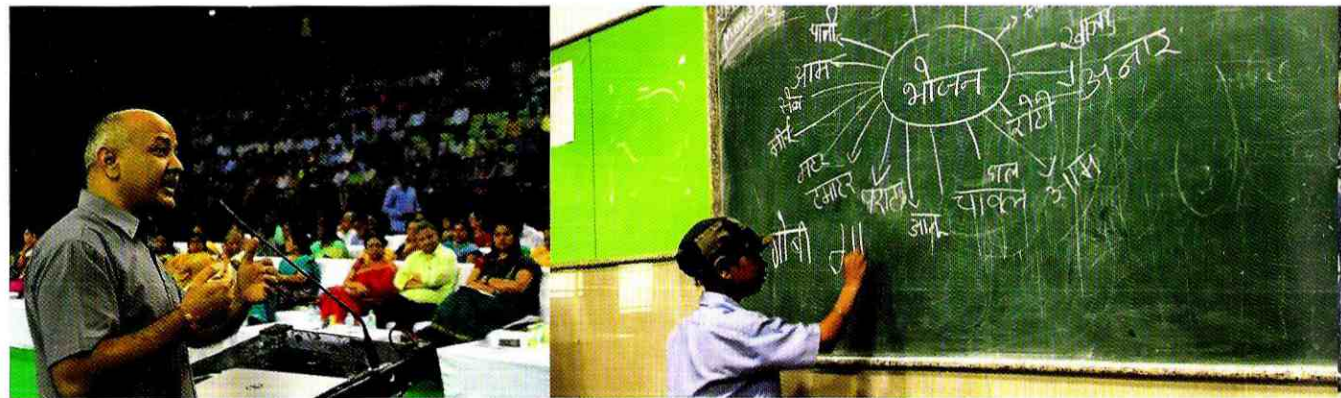
THE STATE TEACHERS AWARD 2018

The Launch of Mission Buniyaad Campaign

The "Mission Buniyaad" campaign conducted from 02nd April 2018 to 30th June 2018, revolutionizing the teaching-learning environment in Govt. Schools as it approached to equip the students of classes 3 to 9 with the reading grade appropriate texts and solve basic maths operations. Its contributory success lead its extension upto 31st July 2018. The target group for this campaign constituted about 4.21 lacs students enrolled in classes 3 to 9 of the DoE's schools which are about 52% of the total enrolled students in these classes. The teachers, students and parents showed exemplary commitment by participating in the campaign even during summer vacations.

As a result of this campaign, about 1.18 lacs students learnt to read their textbooks and 1.40 lacs students learnt to solve division problem.

OBJECTIVE : All children classes III to IX of the schools run by Delhi Government, Municipal Corporations, NDMC and Delhi Cantonment Board should be able to read, write and do basics maths operations.



Living the Dreams: Happiness Curriculum 2018

The Dream Project of Sh. Manish Sisodia, Hon'ble Dy. C.M and Minister of Education, Govt., of NCT of Delhi, the "Happiness Curriculum" materialized with the launch of this mega project by His Holiness Dalai Lama along with Chief Minister of Delhi Sh. Arvind Kejriwal and Dy. C.M. Sh Manish Sisodia on 02.07.18 in the Thyagraj Stadium in Delhi.

The Curriculum, designed by the team of the Directorate of Education has been successfully implemented in the Govt Schools of Delhi on 16.07.18. The Curriculum involves a happiness period of 45 minutes for all the students studying in Nursery up to class VIII with a view to bring, Mindfulness, sustained attention, emotional stability & happiness among them through the practice of Sensory Awareness – Mindful Listening, Mindful Belly Breathing, Mindful Seeing, Mindfulness of Thoughts, Meditation, Present Moment Exercise etc.



Other achievements

ONLINE CAPACITY BUILDING PROGRAMME

SCERT, Delhi has taken a lead role in the country in terms of planning and execution of Online Capacity Building Programme (OCBP) for in-service teachers with the objective to empower teachers in terms of his or her teaching practices and pedagogy through a self-paced 24*7 accessibility.

The total number of teachers 10318 trained under OCBP. So far, 10 trainings in Mathematics and 4 in English have been executed. The participation rate has been around 80%.

In this endeavour, SCERT is going to launch the OCBP for Non-academic areas like Eliminating Corporal Punishment, Preventing Child Sexual Abuse, and Cyber Security.

CAPACITY BUILDING PROGRAMME ON SUBSTANCE ABUSE

SCERT, Delhi has organized Capacity Building Programme on Substance Abuse 'संवाद से संकल्प' for 3500 Government School teachers and officers of Directorate of Education, other local bodies of Delhi at Thyagaraj sports Complex on 8th August 2018.

The aim of this programme is to create awareness among teachers regarding the Substance Abuse as its magnitude is increasing day by day. The Programme was launched by Hon'ble Dy Chief Minister, Shri Manish Sisodia and Justice Mukta Gupta, High Court of Delhi. During the programme sessions were taken by different Resource Persons from Delhi State Legal Service Authority, AIIMS, Directorate of Health Services, Psychologists and NGOs.

NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL ACADEMIC EXPOSURE

- 13 days Leadership programme at Cambridge University for HoS and SCERT/DIET faculty. The Themes covered during programme include Leadership management challenges, Innovation and Change, Supporting the Teaching Staff, Working with large class, Managing Teams etc.
- 5 days Training Program for 30 HOS on 'The Elements of High-Quality Leadership and Management in Finnish Education' has been conducted at University of Jyväskylä, Finland in March 2018
- 5 days Training Program for 30 Teacher Educators on 'Teachers as a Reflective, Professional Practitioner – Developing Teacher Competences' to improve their Professional as well as Pedagogical skills by giving exposure to Finnish education system. This was conducted in collaboration with EduCluster at University of Jyväskylä, Finland in March 2018
- Feedback and Interaction session with the Ambassador of Finland and Hon'ble Education Minister was held on June 27, 2018 with the participants who attended training in Finland.

- 09 Batches of approximately 460 HOS have been trained at IIM Ahmedabad on Leadership for Excellence in Education Programme

CAPACITY BUILDING PROGRAM OF HOS / VICE PRINCIPALS

- 1029 HoS were trained on different administrative, financial etc aspects in Vigyan Bhawan
- Under P- 1024 program Trainings and interactions at CORE and Cluster level have been conducted throughout the year for HoS
- Orientation and Induction programme of newly promoted 628 Vice Principals at SCERT, Delhi from May 21, 2018 to June 15, 2018

TEACHER DEVELOPMENT COORDINATOR (TDC) PROGRAMME

SCERT and DIET along with STIR (NGO) is running a capacity building programme of TDCs. The offsite and onsite capacity building programmes of SCERT/DIET faculty, Head of schools, mentor teachers, administrators are being organised.

MENTOR-TEACHERS

200 Mentor Teachers were selected after a screening process from among the TGTs of the DoE in 2017-18. During 2018-19, 30% of the Mentor teachers were retained and other 70% were replaced by newly appointed Mentor Teachers.

The objective of the program was to support academic activities in schools whereby each Mentor Teacher has been assigned about 5 schools for supporting learning of children. Further, Mentor teachers are involved in implementation of various interventions being carried out by DoE, such as, reading campaign, Chunauti, Pragati, Mega PTM etc.

"ICT IN EDUCATION" CURRICULUM FOR PRE-PRIMARY & PRIMARY CLASSES AND CLASSES 6TH TO 10TH

The Theme based ICT in Education Curriculum for Pre-primary and Primary classes are developed by SCERT, Delhi for the holistic development of the 21st century learners. The 4 interconnected themes are Wellness, Empowering little hands, Digital Art, Buzzing Mind.

SCERT had developed the curriculum on **"ICT in Education"** for classes 6th to 10th for the schools of Delhi with the aim to develop skills that will enable them to function as discerning students in an increasingly digital society and to access various tools & applications for learning and skill development.

Catering Tech. UNDP, NSE, Quest Alliance & others showcased a wide range of career streams, vocational tech & professional courses. Psychometric assessment tests, lectures & interactive sessions proved very lucrative to students.

STRESS MANAGEMENT

To cope up with examination related strategies & stress, a total number of 158 counsellors covered 1015 schools and 84900 students of class X and 84257 students of class XII were counselled during stress management sessions.

YUVA HELPLINE

To lend a helping hand & to provide support to adolescents, teachers & parents, a Toll Free Yuva phone line 1800-11-6888 or 10580 is being run from 7.30 am to 7.00 pm on all working days by DoE. The calls are attended & answered by empathetic counsellors. During board exams 24 X7 HELPLINE remained functional. Besides 5 hopping lines were also started where EVGC & DOE provided not only round the clock tele counselling services, but also walk in and face to face counselling, working in shifts.

SAFE TOUCH - UNSAFE TOUCH

During the Mission Buniyaad Campaign conducted in Summer Vacations, for the students of Classes VI to VIII the sessions on "Safe touch- Unsafe touch" were also conducted to sensitise and empower the students to deal with abuse.

66838 students benefitted from these sessions in 679 schools.

WHERE THERE IS WILL -THERE A WAY: SCHOOLS OF EXCELLENCE

In pursuit Academic Excellence, the Government of NCT of Delhi has opened five Fully English medium schools with state of art infrastructure and other facilities from academic session 2018-19. The schools have become fully functional with an approximate enrollment of 540 students in each school. The schools offer not only conducive environment to foster creativity & academic sparkle among the students but also endeavor to create an institution where even a child from most impoverished background can scale the heights of academic excellence along with holistic development. The DOE plans to open at least one school of excellence in each zone.

PROJECT CAREER GUIDANCE AND CAREER COUNSELLING (CGCC)

An initiative of the Directorate of Education, Government of NCT, Delhi in partnership with UNDP, Central Square Foundation & iDreamCareer.com, Project CGCC was envisioned due to lack of awareness in students about pathways of career options available after class XII. The project CGCC was inaugurated by Sh. Manish Sisodia with an aim to help more than 4 lac students studying in Classes X, XI & XII.

INTERVENTION

A team of psychologists designed a customised psychometric test for Delhi Government school children. This test was made bilingual for the ease of the students and was administered to 4.32 lac students of classes X to XII w.e.f 31st August, 2017 to 9th October, 2017. A 16-page report was generated online on the portal **www.edudelcareer.com** designed for this purpose. The assessment report gives student's strengths, weaknesses, personality traits, interest areas and aptitude along with career recommendations.

PROJECT SMILE

To identify the factors contributing to poor learning in Non Reader Group of students of classes VI to VIII identified through psychometric assessment during Chunauti programme & Individualized education plan (IEP) 19767 students were assessed in all the district w.e.f 18th January, 2018 to 28th March, 2018 during the first phase. Planned Interventional strategies including IEP by SETs, Remedial teaching by subject teachers and Counselling by EVGCs have been adopted to enhance their academic performance up to their optimum potential.

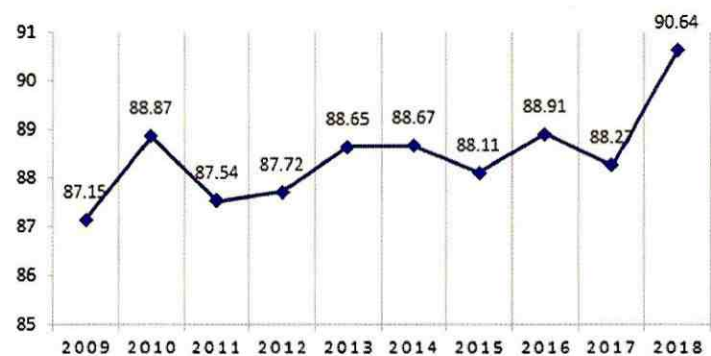
