Our society has always needed such great men whose sacrifices inspire us to give up our lives but do not give up the truth. One of the great men was great sacrificer "Guru Tegh Bahadur Ji". He was the ninth Guru of Sikhs. He was the youngest son of Guru Hargobind Singh Ji. He was known as the Dhruv Star of Sikh.

In 1 April 1621 a child born in Amritsar which named Tayagmal. He was very intelligent. He was a brave and fearless nature since childhood.

At the age of just 14, he showed valor in the war against the attack of the Mughals. Impressed by his bravery, his father changed his name from Tayagmal to Tegh Bahadur.

In his earlier days, he learned several

languages such as Gurumukhi / Gurmukhi, Hindi, Sanskrit and other languages of religious philosophy, when he was known as Tegh Bahadur, he spent his time in studies and meditation. Time passed and soon he got married to mata Gajri at Karatpur in 1632.

Soon the responsibility of instructing and guiding the Sikh community has/was on Guru Tegh Bahadur. He sacrificed his life for the welfare of people.

The important event of the Guru Tegh Bahadur life is defend one's religion. November 1675, on this when he was beheaded by Mughal Emperor Aurangzeb. Often referred to as Hindi ki chadar, which means shield of Hindi, Guru Tegh Bahadur is

The mughal ruler wanted to convert all Indians into muslims. He wanted everyone to either take up Islam or else be prepared for execution.

After this announcement by Aurangzeb, a group of 500 Kashmiri pandits led by pandit Krishna Ram went to Sikh help from Guru Tegh Bahadur at Amandpur sahib on hearing this atrocities of Aurangzeb, Gobind Rai, the son of Guru Tegh Bahadur declared that it is only father who can solve this problem.

The ninth guru of Sikhs hadily agreed to help the pandits. He asked them to inform the mughal rulers that if they are able to convert Guru

After Aurangzeb came to know about this Guru Tegh Bahadur was arrested and presented before the Mughal rulers.

Guru Tegh Bahadur clearly refuse to take up Islam. As a result, he along with his followers were physically tortured for five days. As a result, Aurangzeb beheaded him at the Chandani Chowk in broad daylight. Guru Tegh Bahadur, who gave his life to protect the religion of others will always be in our heart.
