STRATEGIES FOR LOW ACHIEVERS

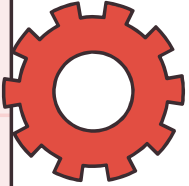
- Regular attendance monitoring
- Provide regular counselling and motivation to the students
- Students should be asked to set their own learning goals/targets
- Focus and practice of MUST DO SYLLABUS provided by the department
- Practice of important topics of high weightage and frequently asked in exams
- Teaching of difficult topics with flow chart/illustrations
- 20 Minutes Capsule Classes with bullet point during remedial teaching for identified needy students only
- Create peer learning group including some high achiever students
- Ensure more and more writing practice
- Real life examples/uses of every theory and fact
- Inculcate habits of writing answers with key words, underline and heading
- To the point answer with bullet points
- Practice of MCQs, Imp. Questions, Support Material
- Regular contact with parents to guide them for betterment of the child
- **We complete two revision cycles with multiple assessments before Final/Board Exams**



STRATEGIES FOR HIGH ACHIEVERS

- Time Management- guidance and practice as per marking scheme (Blue Print)
- Motivate students to set their own challenging goals and time bound action plan
- Adequate written practice of Sample Question Papers issued by CBSE & DOE
- Analysis of Answer Sheets of Board Toppers for getting better ideas for answering
- Proper explanation to the students regarding how to fascinate the examiner by their writing skills and capture the extra marks
- Practice of Tough, Analytical & Source Based Topics as per Blue Print
- Students should be asked to exchange their test papers and check them again
- Formation of Questions by the students along with marking scheme for better comprehension of answers and Generation of Question Bank of class for practice
- Weekly 3 hour test and self assessment of the students and exchange of answer sheets with other students for better understanding of presentation
- Identify Excellent Quality Audio Video Support Material available on various online platforms like DIKSHA, NCERT, CBSE etc. and share the same to the students
- Group discussions on difficult topics in the presence of subject teacher
- Motivate students to ask probing & high order thinking question

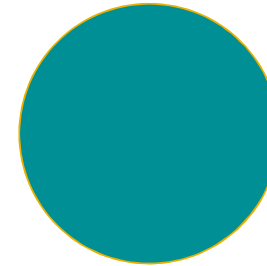
OUR SCHOOL IS A DEMOCRATIC SCHOOL (A FLAT ORGANISATION).

60% of our staff is Google L1 Certified Educators



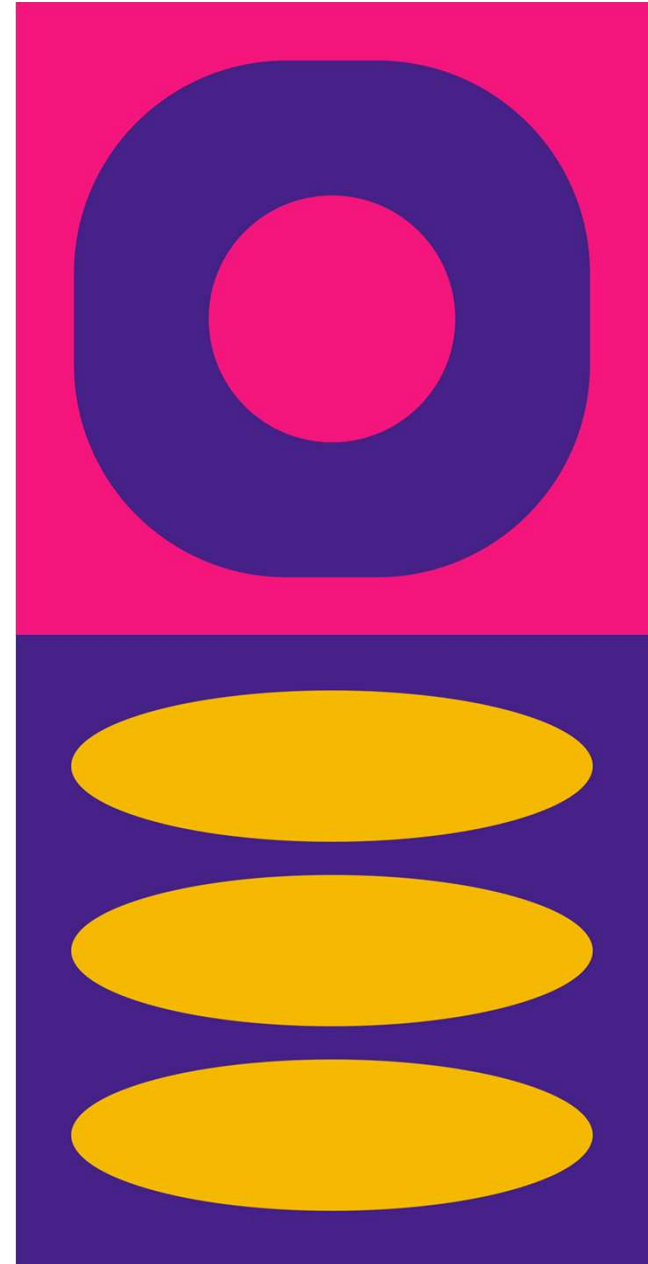
