"How was the interaction in Classes today?"


"Which new strategies were used?"

Encouraging a system that supports strengthening of subject understanding through:


- regular assessment through

Periods are allotted in time table for class with K-Yan.


5.promoting active - learning and collaborative techniques in classrooms.

- 6. organizing remedial classes for students with learning challenges, giving emphasis on written practice for long term retention.
- 7. asking students to frame One word or One sentence answered Questions from within the topics taught on daily basis. This helps students to identify key elements in the text like who, what, when, where etc.





- 8..arranged Counselling sessions for emotional and academic challenges to :
- i) help students manage stress and anxiety.
- ii) provide guidance on study habits, time management.
- iii) offer information on career options, courses, and entrance exams after Class X and XII.
- iv) improve interpersonal skills, self-esteem, and communication.
- v) Vidyanjali sessions by experts in their fields offer ample motivation and support.

- 10. promote an understanding and appreciation of diverse backgrounds, cultures and abilities among students.
- 11. motivate students to participate in Sports, Arts and Club activities for their all round development. Promote student oriented assemblies organised by Student Advisory Board for developing leadership qualities and a sense of belongingness.
- 12. conduct regular workshops to foster empathy, understanding and acceptance for CWSN.
