IN-DEPTH RESULT ANALYSIS

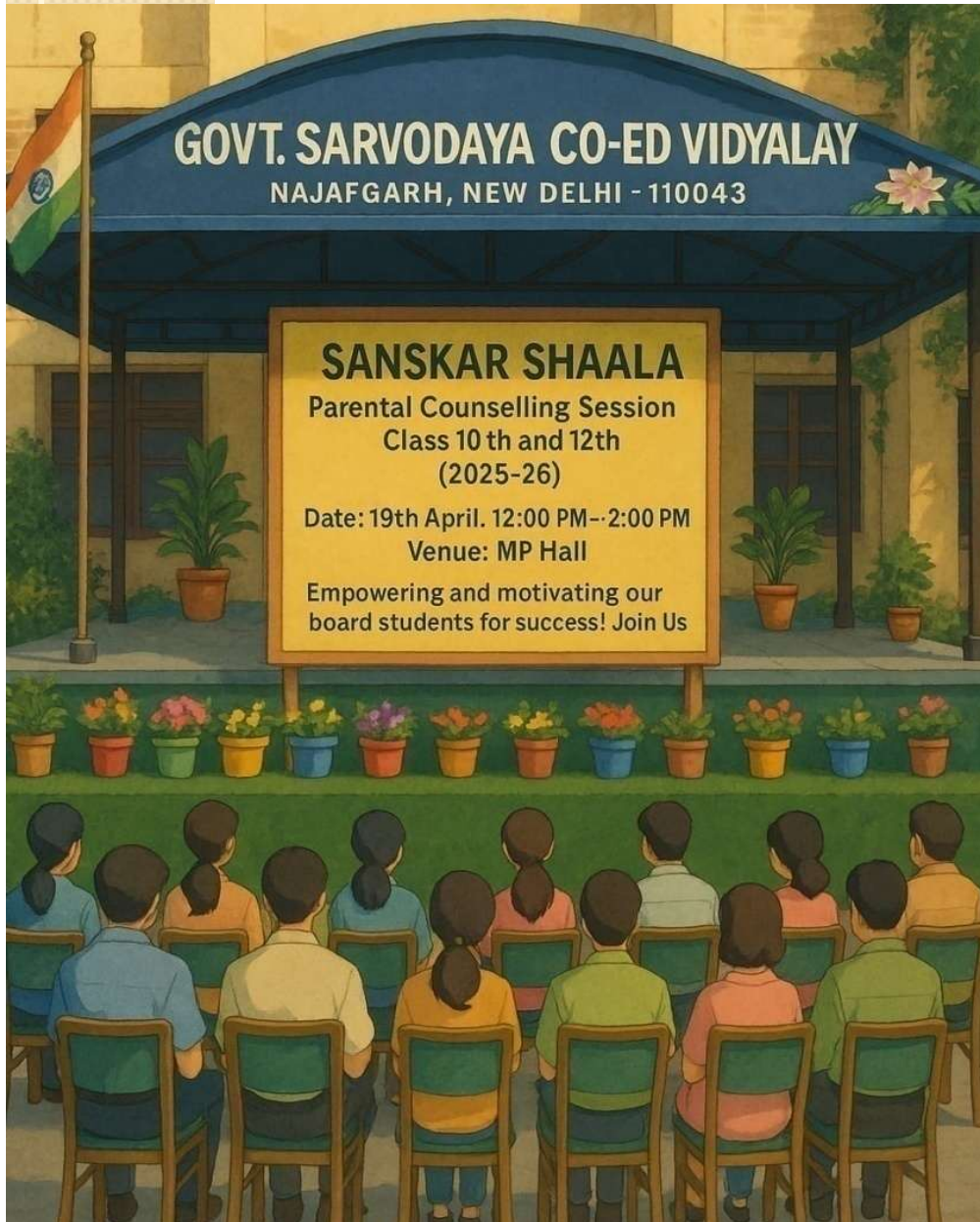


Monitoring Attendance
