CIRCULAR

Subject – Guidelines for Admission Test in Classes VI, IX and XI in CM SHRI Schools for the Session 2026-27.

The Government of NCT of Delhi established 75 CM SHRI Schools during the session 2025-26. These schools have been declared as ‘**Specified Category**’ schools in accordance with the provisions of Section 2(p) of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education (RTE) Act, 2009. These schools are affiliated with the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE).

The CM SHRI schools aim at ensuring greater autonomy and flexibility with a focus on promoting excellence and equity in public schooling. These schools are designed to serve as model educational institutions, equipped with modern infrastructure and advanced teaching methodologies aligned with NEP 2020, NCFSE and NCFSS. The admission to these schools will prioritize talented and deserving meritorious students with high potential, thereby enabling them to access high-quality education and fulfill their academic and career aspirations.

Keeping in view of the above, and to ensure a transparent, equitable, and merit-based admission process, an Admission Test - “**CM SHRI Schools Admission Test – 2026**” will be conducted under the aegis of the CM SHRI Branch of the Directorate of Education, GNCTD, to fill the vacant seats in Classes VI, IX and XI for the current academic Session 2026-27, as per the details available in **Annexure I, II and III**.

The modalities for CM SHRI Schools Admission Test (Classes VI, IX and XI) – 2026 are as follows:

1. The age criteria and reservation policy applicable for admissions in classes VI, IX and XI, will be in line with the norms prescribed by the Directorate of Education, Govt of NCT of Delhi.
2. Only those students shall be eligible to apply for admission in Classes VI, IX and XI who are **residents of Delhi**, and have passed the classes V, VIII and X, respectively, **during the academic session 2025-26 from a recognised school located in Delhi**.
3. To promote equitable access, at least **50%** of the seats shall be reserved for students who have passed the classes V, VIII and X from Government Schools, including those under the Directorate of Education (DoE), Municipal Corporations (MCD), New Delhi Municipal Council (NDMC), Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs), Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas (JNVs) and Government-Aided Schools, **located in Delhi only**.
4. The minimum qualifying marks for the eligibility in the merit list under General category shall be **25%**. A relaxation of 5% in eligibility marks is offered to the candidates from SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer) / Children with Special Needs (CWSN) as per the policy of Directorate of Education, Govt. of Delhi. The admission shall, however, be based on the actual cutoff score applicable for the school, class and category of the candidate concerned.
5. **Once a school is allotted, no request for transfer to another school will be entertained. Therefore, candidates must fill in their school preferences carefully.**
6. For Class **VI**, a school shall be allotted to a candidate only if the candidate has opted for that school in the application form and meets the cutoff score of that particular school, as applicable to the candidate’s category. However, two choices (in preferential order) may be opted in the application form by the candidate. In view of point 5, no transfer would be allowed after the allotment of school based on the cutoff.



7. For Class **IX**, a common merit list shall be prepared for all schools with available vacancies. School allotment will be made based on the candidate's score, category, and the three school preferences selected in the application form. Once allotted, no request for transfer shall be entertained from one school campus to another.
8. For Class **XI**, applicants must indicate three school preferences, and preferences related to the choice of stream – Paper I [High End 21st Century Skill Courses (STEM)] and Paper II [for High End 21st Century Skill Courses (Finance); Humanities and Performing & Visual Arts Courses] in the application form. Please refer to **Annexure II** for more details. Candidate may appear for any one or both the Papers I and II. School allotment shall be made from the paper-wise common merit list, based on the candidate's preferences, score and category. Once allotted, no request for transfer shall be entertained from one school campus to another or **for stream change**.
9. **Timeline of the Test:** The timeline for admission test related activities is given as under.

10. **Design and Blueprint of the Test:** The paper shall be an OMR based objective type test. Class wise syllabus of the test paper shall be made available online on the website of DoE, along with a sample copy of an OMR sheet to familiarise the aspiring candidates in advance. The question paper shall be bilingual for Class VI, while that of Classes IX and XI shall be in English medium only. There shall be no negative marking in the question paper for class VI, while there shall be provision of negative marking in the question papers for Classes IX and XI – one fourth of the marks allotted to a question will be deducted for each incorrect response. Extra time shall be provided to CWSN candidates as per the extant norms of Govt of NCT of Delhi. The design and blueprint of the admission test question papers for different classes are given below.

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Important Instructions for Filling the Online Application Form

1. Register using a valid mobile number, as it cannot be changed later.
2. Note down the registration number sent to your registered mobile number and email ID for future reference.
3. Upload a recent passport-size photograph that is clear and properly visible. Caps should not be worn, and the face must be clearly visible.
4. Upload the CWSN certificate, if applicable. Validity of the certificate will, however, be checked by the allotted school at the time of admission.
5. Mention the details related to SC/ST or OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) certificate issued by the competent authority of the Government of NCT of Delhi, if applicable. Validity of the certificate will, however, be checked by the allotted school at the time of admission.
6. Select the preferred school(s): **(Pay attention)**
 - Two schools (one from each set) for Class VI
 - Three schools for Classes IX and XI
7. Fill the details related to the preferred stream – Paper I and Paper II for Class XI.
8. Download the registration form and review all details carefully. Make necessary corrections during the correction window, if required.
